

Ready-to-use monitor containing all 24 stains from the IKW Laundry Recommendation.

In 2025, the German Cosmetic, Toiletry, Perfumery and Detergent Association (IKW), will release the first part a brand new IKW Recommendation for the Quality Assessment of the Product Performance of Laundry detergents. This first part contains the stains and a method to test the cleaning performance of Laundry detergents. CFT released a ready-to-use monitor containing all the stains mentioned in the standard. The product code for this is MON-IKW 2025.

At later moments, the other parts of standard will be released containing secondary performance like colour fastness and dye transfer, pilling and other tests.
